1	-	-	The PD Forum welcomes the continued development of this methodology. However, our members would like to highlight a practical implementation challenge that may affect its uptake. Project developers applying the previous version of the methodology (A6.4-AMM-001) to real-world projects have encountered difficulties interpreting several requirements, particularly the interaction between the methane component, the energy components and the business-as-usual/downward-adjustment provisions. Translating these provisions into implementable calculation models has also proven challenging.	We encourage the Methodological Expert Panel to consider whether the revised methodology has been validated through pilot applications or fully worked implementation examples. The publication of end-to-end worked examples demonstrating the complete application of the methodology—from baseline determination through monitoring and emission reduction calculations—would significantly improve transparency, facilitate consistent implementation and reduce the risk of differing interpretations by project developers. In addition, we encourage the MEP to consider establishing a streamlined mechanism through which stakeholders can seek technical clarifications while applying methodologies in practice. Such a mechanism would promote more consistent implementation, improve stakeholder confidence and ultimately strengthen the quality and integrity of Article 6 activities.
