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Draft Methodological tool: Reversal risk assessment

1	-	General	Several of the questions asked to stakeholders or strategic topics in the draft tool concern topics that (i) are either too demanding for individual stakeholders to suggest robust and in depth proposals capable of properly addressing the involved matters in a short period of time, such as the call for inputs or (ii) are already practiced in different carbon market mechanisms, e.g., ratings of different risk factors such as natural or human induced, as well as measures to reduce reversal risks, leading to reductions in risk factors. Even though the MEP has stated that this tool is applicable for clean cooking activities and that it is already working on other tools, e.g. forestry, geological removals and biochar, we believe a centralized paper would be highly beneficial to the debate, building upon a wider range of proposed solutions and of empirical experiences over more than 20 years of voluntary carbon markets.	Request a mandated from the Supervisory Body to enable the MEP, with the support of the Secretariat, to develop a technical paper, based on a comparative analysis of existing experiences in the carbon market regarding reversal risk assessments for removal activities, covering not only the questions directly asked to stakeholders in MP-014-08 but also, the major parameters and criteria for the assessment of reversals and its risks.
