Until December 31, 2025 (monitoring period), Myanmar will receive 10% and Climate Change Center will receive 90% of the CERs or A6.4 ERs (as determined in accordance with the CA).

After December 31, 2025, the same allocation ratio will either be maintained, or it will be determined under another LOA (Letter of Authorization) issued based on further negotiations in accordance with another CA.

**b. 10471-P1-0007-CP1 ~ 10471-P1-0054-CP1**

Until May 31, 2026 (monitoring period), Myanmar will receive 20% and Climate Change Center will receive 80% of the CERs or A6.4 ERs (as determined in accordance with the CA).

After May 31, 2026, the same allocation ratio will either be maintained, or it will be determined under another LOA (Letter of Authorization) issued based on further negotiations in accordance with another CA.
