<b>A brief description of the technologies or measures to be deployed:</b>	<p>10.35 MW PV CDM Project (“the Project”) is to construct and operate photovoltaic power generation project with the total capacity of 10.35 MW in the central region of Chile. The project is expected to generate about 19,350 MWh annually and will connect to the Santa Elvira(15kV) power grid in the country (“the Grid”).</p> <p>This project activity will utilize renewable energy sources for power generation, which contributes to GHG emission reduction by displacing existing power generation activities based on fossil fuel including oil and coal. As a result, the operation of the proposed solar power plant will result in the reduction of CO<sub>2</sub>.</p>

The project is expected to generate about 19,350 MWh annually.</p> <p>After factoring in the Combined Margin Emissions Factor of 0.6507 which is the factor of a similar CDM project in Chile, the estimated annual Carbon Emission Reduction (CER) amount is 12,591 tCO<sub>2</sub>eq per year</p>
